

Trinity College London is an international exam board which provides GESE assessments. GESE is an internationally recognised and reliable assessment of a student's ability to communicate face-to-face in English. This course aims to help children build confidence in English language communication to carry out several speaking and listening tasks with fluency and accuracy.

Our school will supply a preparation book for each student and assist in enrolling for the assessment (extra cost applies). The assessment will last approximately 5 minutes and students have the option to take the online exam either at home or at a designated centre.
