They will explore rhythm, melody, dynamic, tempo and more through playful games, instruments and singing.

The program integrates the four essential language skills of listening, speaking, reading, and writing to provide a comprehensive foundation in English. A key feature is the small-group instructional setting, which offers each student ample opportunity to practise and refine their proficiency. Instruction is delivered through interactive methods, including games, music, and levelled reading materials, which are carefully tailored to differentiate for individual needs. Younger participants primarily focus on oral skills, such as pronunciation and vocabulary expansion, while older students advance to guided reading and introductory written exercises. The overarching goal is to cultivate confident and capable English communicators.




