By the end of this unit:

Children will explore the different relationships in their lives, including those with family, friends, and teachers, and how these interactions affect their well-being. They will gain a clearer understanding of their self-identity and emotions, and they will learn conflict resolution skills. Additionally, they will examine the importance of positive relationships and how these connections contribute to emotional support and personal growth.



How you can support your child at home:

- Recollect Sweet Memories: Involve your child in making an album of their family members. Browse through the album, guiding and encouraging your child to learn more about their family and who they are.
- **Social Stories**: Read a few stories to your child to reinforce positive behaviours within relationships such as caring, sharing, playing together and helping others.
